Women's Services Scan Information



During your pregnancy, you will have 2 Routine Scans.

1st Scan (Approx 11 weeks)

This will tell us how many weeks pregnant you are and when your baby is due. You will also be offered Combined Ultrasound and Biophysical Scanning (CUB screening). This is a scan and a blood test which will tell us if you have an increased chance of having a Down's syndrome baby.

2nd Scan (Approx 20 weeks)

This is a detailed scan which tells us if your baby has any structural defects. Not all defects are detectable. (Your Midwife will discuss this with you through your interpreter).

If we provide an interpreter for your scan appointment, we will ask for your permission to pass on your telephone number. This will enable the interpreter to contact you by telephone on our behalf to let you know the result of your scans.

In some cases it may not be possible to tell you the result by telephone. In these cases you will be given an appointment to see your Doctor or Midwife.
